She is the current convenor for the Diploma in the History of Medicine offered by the Worshipful society of Apothecaries of London and is extensively involved with plans to develop the subject at postgraduate level. When required she also acts as consultant to museums and television companies to ensure that medical history is portrayed in a lively yet accurate manner. She is presently involved with two new publications, both of which will focus on maritime medicine.
